HOA DUES & BUDGET

HOA dues are considered late after **January 31, 2026**. Per our bylaws, fines will be assessed starting in **February 1, 2026** on all past-due fees of \$75.00. Your dues cover essential community expenses, including water, electricity, and landscaping. The current Board has successfully **reduced the dues amount** for this year and is continuing to find ways to reduce expenditures in the future. All Board members are volunteers, and we appreciate your continued support.

DEED RESTRICTIONS & MAINTENANCE

Quakers Landing is a deed-restricted community designed to maintain a high standard for our neighborhood. Please be mindful of the following common regulations:

- **Trash & Recycle Bins:** Bins must not be visible from the street. They may be placed at the curb no earlier than **5:00 PM** the day before pickup and must be removed by **8:00 PM** the day of pickup.
- **Green Waste:** Tree limbs or hedge cuttings must not exceed **three feet** in length. Bundles of green waste or trash must not exceed **50 lbs.**

These restrictions were in place when you moved into Quakers Landing, and your help in keeping our community looking its best is greatly appreciated.
